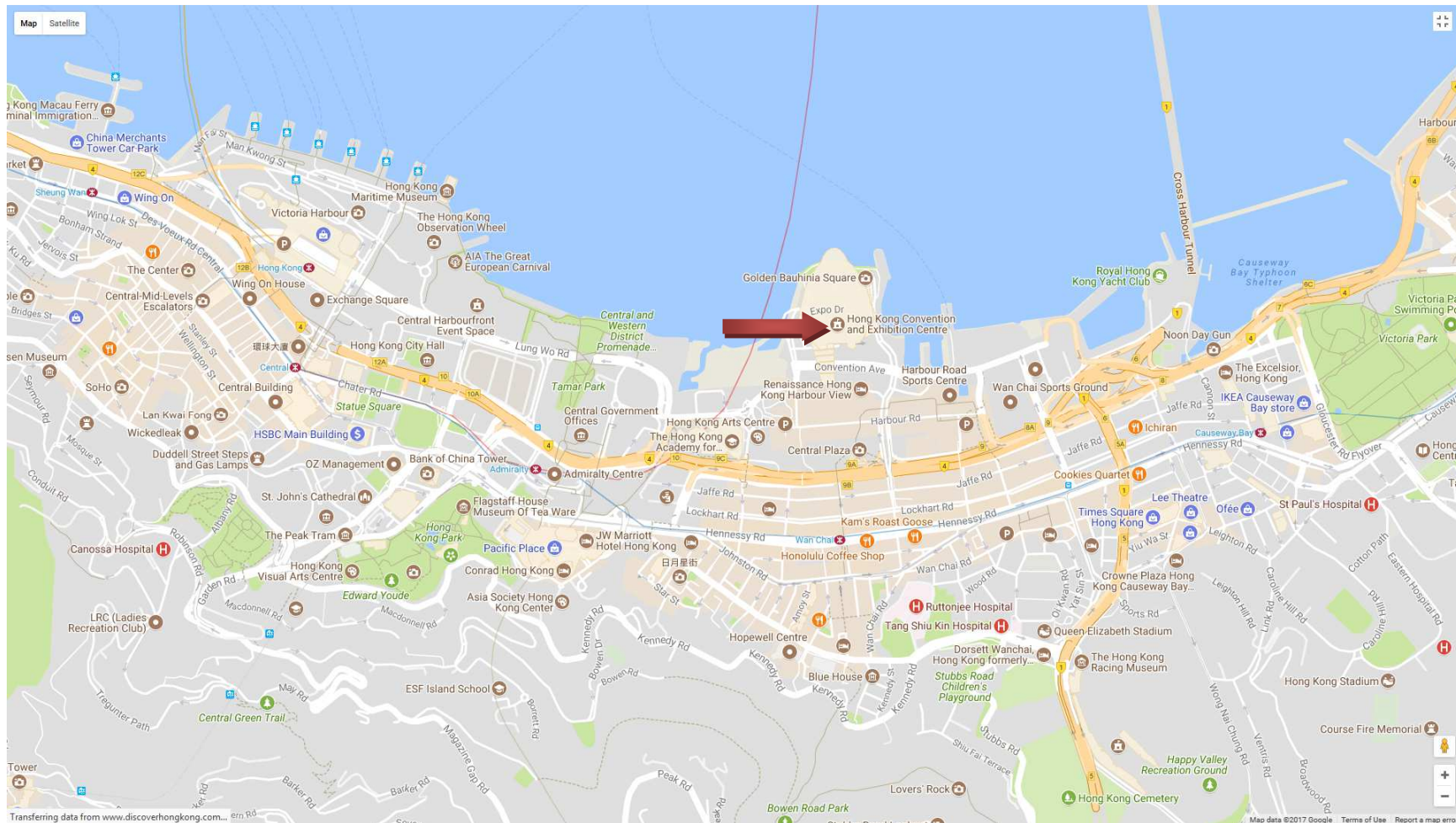


Hong Kong Island Main Business/Convention Center District:

This map shows the main business areas on Hong Kong Island. The Wan Chia area around the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre (HKCEC) is easily accessible through elevated walkways from the Convention Centre's complex and has many shopping and dining outlets. It is also a short walk to the Wan Chai MTR station. The Admiralty, and Central stations close to Wan Chai also offer shopping and dining districts in the direct vicinity of the stations. These three stations would make up what is considered the downtown area on Hong Kong Island.



Kowloon Peninsula:

The Tsim Sha Tsui area of Kowloon Peninsula is also considered “Downtown” Hong Kong. It is located just across the harbor from the HKCEC and there is a ferry that operates frequently between the Wan Chai pier adjacent to the Convention Centre and the Tsim Sha Tsui pier. The ferry takes just a few minutes and costs less than US\$0.50 one way.
